Terms & Conditions

- By entering this competition, the entrant will be deemed to have accepted these rules and agrees to be bound by them
- This competition is administered by the Whitehorse Manningham Regional Library Corporation (WMRLC), 1040 Whitehorse Road, Box Hill, VIC 3128
- The competition opens on Thursday 1st September 2022 and closes at midnight on Monday 31st October 2022.

Entrant requirements

- Entrants must hold a current Whitehorse Manningham Library membership card
- Employees/volunteers of WMRLC and their immediate families are not eligible to enter
- Entrants under 18 must obtain permission from parent or guardian before entering competition
- Either entrant or photographic subject must have a demonstrable connection with the municipalities of Whitehorse or Manningham (e.g. live, work or study within the boundaries of the two Council areas)
- Entrants and subjects agree to use of their name and photograph in any publicity surrounding the competition, including but not limited to media, printed publications and electronic media, the WMRLC website and social media pages
- Entrants and subjects agree to participate and co-operate as required in promotional activities relating to the competition, including but not limited to being photographed.

Submission requirements

- Entrants may only submit one piece of work in this competition
- Submissions are to feature a local family member/person of significance who:
 - Is over 65 years of age;
 - Is a positive and/or sensitive depiction
- Submissions are to be in photographic format, with accompanying text description up to 100 words.
- All entries are to be submitted electronically via WMRLC social media platforms (Facebook or Instagram) by midnight on Monday 31st October 2022.
- All language submissions are welcome, but non-English submissions must include English language translation.
- Submissions must be the individual entrant’s own original work. By entering, the applicant warrants that the work has not been published elsewhere (including electronically) and that they own the copyright to the work.
- Entries that are considered of an offensive nature will be rejected.
- There is no entry fee.
- Copyright remains with the creator. By submitting an entry, participants grant WMRLC a perpetual and non-exclusive licence to display or publish the entry including the entrant’s name on the WMRLC website and/or catalogue and to any promotional photographs in all media without a fee.

Competition judging and prizes

- One winner will be nominated from all submissions.
- Main prize will be \$100 Readings Bookstore Voucher.

- Judging criteria includes:
 - Creativity and innovation of presentation and content;
 - Overall quality of final product.
- The outcome of the competition is final in every situation and no correspondence will be entered into
- Prizes are non-transferrable
- WMRLC reserves the right to withdraw a prize after it has been awarded if an entrant is unable to satisfy these terms and conditions
